Symbolic interaction theory analyzes society by addressing the **subjective meanings** that people impose on objects, events, and behaviors.

Symbolic interactionism focuses on three main aspects of communication: meaning, language, and thought. The human ability to interpret symbols and analyze viewpoints through thinking allows meaning to emerge.

Through language and communication, symbols provide the means by which reality is constructed.

Culture is the world of symbols in which human beings live.
