The ultimate goal is to **deconstruct and unlearn myths** by teaching individuals to think differently.

To develop knowledge, disseminate **a comprehensive understanding** with the ultimate goal of changing life chances.

Cast away myths and **reinvigorate a self-critical discourse by** acknowledging error and thinking critically.
